

LongRange injectible cattle dewormer is a new product on the market that offers 100-150 days of parasite control in a single dose. LongRange, the first extended-release injection, provides these 100 days of continuous parasite control by breaking the parasite life cycle, thus reducing parasite burden on the pasture. This product helps prevent parasite infections caused by internal parasites such as brown stomach worms, lung worms, nodula worms, and small intestine worms.

Adult cows typically have a higher internal parasite immunity compared to calves. Because of this, we recommend using this product on calves and yearlings, or in the event that your adult cows become heavily parasitized. A fecal analysis can be performed at the clinic to determine the amount of parasite infestation that exists in your herd.

LongRange is a prescription dewormer and may be purchased in 50, 250, or 500 mL bottles. One mL per 110lb of body weight should be given by subcutaneous injection in front of the animal's shoulder. It will cost roughly \$6.70 to deworm one 550lb calf using LongRange. If a 50mL bottle is used, it should be discarded after 15 stopper punctures. Automatic syringe equipment should be used on 250 and 500mL bottles to reduce amount of stopper punctures. It is most economical to only purchase the amount of product that you plan to use within the first three months of the bottle being punctured.
